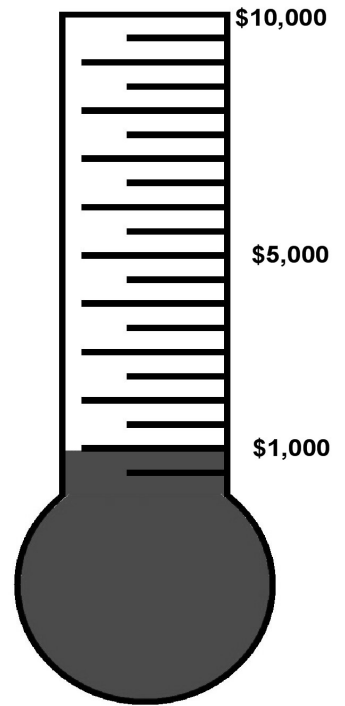

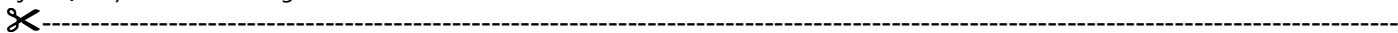
Cabaret at the Playhouse
