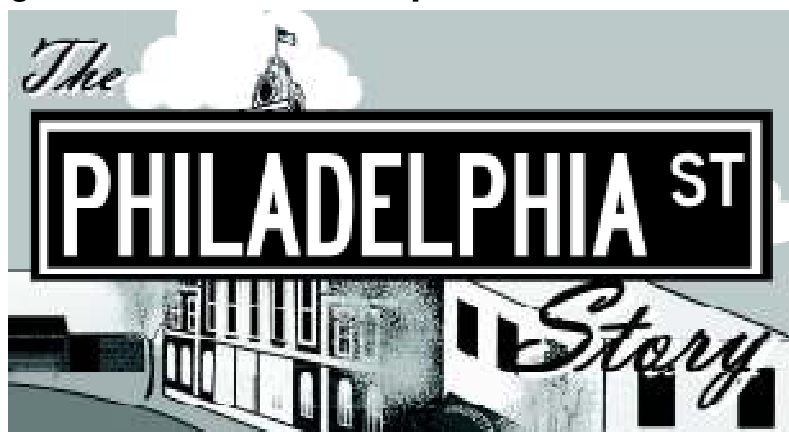

# 2011 Indiana Players Scholarship Program

A scholarship of \$1,000 will be awarded to a deserving, college-bound high school senior or junior who has been a contributing member of the Indiana Players and the Philadelphia Street Playhouse.

## Qualifications:

1. The student must have volunteered a significant number of hours of community service to the Indiana Players and contributed to our community playhouse.
2. The student must be accepted into a college, community college, or trade school. It does not require the major to be of the theater arts.
3. The student must have a record of good academic performance as well as extracurricular and community activities outside of the Indiana Playhouse.
4. The student must have a need for financial assistance in paying for college, community college, or trade school.
5. The student should include two written recommendations from teachers, theater directors, community leaders, etc. One letter should be from a member of the Indiana Players.

Deadline for all scholarship entrees must be postmarked no later than **March 31, 2011**. The scholarship will be awarded either at the Indiana Players annual board meeting, May 18, 2011, or at the students' school during the graduation ceremony. The scholarship will be paid jointly to the student and the college to which he/she has been accepted. If the student does not attend the selected college, community college, or trade school the scholarship will be forfeited.
