ABOUT THE SHOW:

A clerical error, and a pushy mother, results in Harlan Howe, an out-of-work salesman, being called in to interview for the position of Messenger of Death. Through a series of mishaps, Regional Death 143 is required to hire Harlan and train him for the position. The first play in the “Heaven, Incorporated” series, “A New Death” humorously imagines how Heaven and the divine might work as a typical corporation, asking questions about why humans die and the nature of the Creator’s plan. Was the hiring of Harlan a simple mistake, or are all events part of a greater order we cannot comprehend?
